

BOOK CLUB READING GUIDE

1. How did your feelings about Vixen change during the story? What do you think she discovered about herself while she was with Broken Peak Pack?
2. What does Bray need from Vixen? What does Vixen need from Bray? What do they bring to each other?
3. How do you feel about Mac? Is he a trickster or a wise old man? If you had the knowledge Mac had, would you have handled Bray any differently?
4. How does Vixen change the status quo of Broken Peak Pack? Who do you think would be more affected if Vixen left Broken Peak? Bray or the Pack?
5. When Vixen goes to Leighton when he has his nightmare, we see the scene mostly from Vixen's perspective. What do you think Leighton's perspective would be like? How would it be different if told from Bray's point of view?
6. Think about Vixen's relationship with the pack. Why do you think she doesn't ignore them during her stay? Why do you think the pack is different (or similar) to the special ops team she worked with before coming to Broken Peak?
7. How does the pack change during Vixen's stay? What role does the pack play in Vixen's finding reasons not to leave?
8. What does Vixen learn about trust during her stay at Broken Peak? Do you think she's ever trusted anyone before?
9. Where do Mac and Roose fit into Vixen's education about Shifters? Do you think Vixen would come to the same conclusions if Mac and Roose weren't there?
10. Why do you think the novel is titled Broken Hero? Do you think Vixen is Broken?
11. How does Vixen's view on who and what she was (and is) impact her decisions?
12. Jules is praised by readers for creating strong heroines who are equals of the heroes. How did Broken Hero's treatment of Vixen effect your expectations of other books you've read by Jules or other Paranormal Romance authors?
